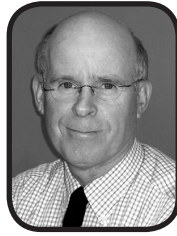
Gary Bennett

Dr. Bennett is professor of entomology and coordinator of the Center of Urban and Industrial Pest Management at Purdue University. Gary has spent over 4 decades in the structural pest control industry. He received an M.S. and Ph.D. degree in urban entomology. Thousands of copies of his classic book, **Scientific Guide to Pest Control Operations**, are in use. He is involved in research, extension and teaching programs. He is recognized as an excellent advisor for entomology students. Gary has received numerous awards for his outstanding contributions to urban pest management.



James Campbell

Dr. Campbell is a research entomologist with the USDA-ARS Grain Marketing and Production Research Center in Manhattan, Kansas. He received his Ph.D. in Entomology from the University of California-Davis. His research focuses on the behavior and ecology of stored-product insect pests and using this information to improve pest management programs.



Robert Corrigan

Dr. "Bobby" Corrigan is the president of RMC Pest Management Consulting. He received his B.S., M.S. and Ph.D. degrees from Purdue University where he worked for 15 years conducting research and teaching programs in urban pest management, emphasizing rodent control. His industry experience includes three years as a PMP and one year as a technical specialist for Terminix International. Bobby's acclaimed book, **Rodent Pest Management: A Practical Guide for Pest Management Professionals**, was published in 2001.



Robert W. Davis

Bob received his Ph.D. in urban entomology from the University of Nebraska and has acquired field experience in the structural pest control industry while working as a technical director for ABC Pest Control in Austin, Texas. Keeping focus on termites and other structural pests, Bob has worked for Aventis and Bayer and is currently working for BASF, Inc. He has been a regular contributor to our UPM Conference and made numerous presentations on termites, ants, pesticide safety, and technician training at various PCO conferences in other states.



Jerry Heath

Mr. Jerry Heath received a B.S. in Entomology from Washington State University. Dr. Merchant has 22 years of experience as an Extension specialist in urban entomology at Texas A&M University, Dallas. Prior to graduate school, Michael worked as a technician for a major pest control company. He trains pest management professionals and oversees a community IPM project.
