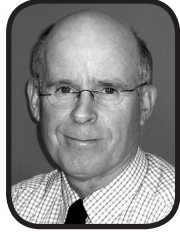

FEATURED SPEAKERS



Dr. Gary Bransess

Dr. Bransess received his Ph.D. in urban entomology from Purdue University. He worked for Bayer CropScience for 21 years, focusing on urban pest problems in the Midwest. Recently, he founded Yosemite Environmental Services, a company providing services on research, training, technology transfer and legal support in the pest management industry. Dr. Bransess is contributing editor to the **Handbook of Pest Control, 10th ed.**, and author of the chapter, "Insecticides and Pesticide Safety".



Dr. Bobby Corrigan

Dr. Corrigan is president of RMC Pest Management Consulting. He received his B.S., M.S. and Ph.D. degrees from Purdue University where for 15 years he conducted programs in urban pest management, emphasizing rodent control. His industry experience includes 3 years as a PMP and a year as a technical specialist for Terminix International. Bobby is author of **Rodent Control: A Practical Guide for Pest Management Professionals**, and is contributing editor to the **Handbook of Pest Control, 10th ed.**



Dr. Bill Donahue

Dr. Donahue is the Senior Scientist and owner of Sierra Research Laboratories, Inc. in Modesto, California. SRL is an independent contract research laboratory specializing in testing new chemicals and devices for insect control in the fields of urban and veterinary entomology. Dr. Donahue received his B.A. in Biological Sciences from San Jose State University and his Ph.D. in Entomology from Texas A&M University. He worked for Zoëcon Corporation for 14 years before starting his own laboratory in 1994.



Ms. Gail Getty

Ms. Getty received her B.S. in entomology and M.S. in wood science and technology from the University of California-Berkeley. She has over 18 years of experience in conducting scientific research on urban insect biology, ecology, chemical ecology and behavior. She has published over 21 scientific papers. Her projects have involved major manufacturing companies. She has been an expert witness in bed bug, termite, beetle, and construction defect lawsuits. Recently, Ms. Getty formed the Getty Entomological Research and Consulting Company.



Dr. Tom Janousek

Dr. Janousek received his B.S. from Creighton University in Omaha and Ph.D. from Texas A&M University. He was a post-doctoral researcher at the University of Nebraska in Lincoln for a few years and conducted research on mosquitoes. He is a Lieutenant Colonel in the U.S. Army Reserve. Dr. Janousek formed a company in 1999 called Pest Consulting Services, based in Omaha. Dr. Janousek has been monitoring the West Nile virus for several years. He has traveled extensively to assist with mosquito abatement programs.



Dr. Dini Miller

Dr. Miller is a professor of entomology and an Urban Pest Management Extension Specialist at Virginia Tech. She received her M.S. and Ph.D. degrees from the University of Florida where her research focused on behavior and management of German cockroaches. Dr. Miller conducts research on insecticide efficacy and outreach programs on German cockroaches, bed bugs and other urban pests. She has won numerous awards for her work in urban entomology.



Dr. Stuart Mitchell

Dr. Mitchell is an entomologist with the Pest West Company in Des Moines, IA. He has over 22 years of experience in the pest management industry and holds a B.S. in physics, a Masters of Science in pest management, a Ph.D. in entomology, and a Doctor of Science in osteopathic medicine. He is a Board Certified Entomologist (BCE) and a Certified Wildlife Control Professional (CWCP). He is a regular contributor to **Pest Management Magazine** and **Pest Control Technology** magazine.



Dr. Thomas Phillips

Dr. Phillips received his M.S. and Ph.D. in entomology from State University of New York. He is a professor of entomology at Kansas State University, Manhattan, KS and conducts research on stored grain pests dealing with pheromones, attractants and semiochemicals. He has published over 50 papers in peer reviewed journals and 7 book chapters. He is a co-author of the fumigation chapter in 9th ed. in **Mallis Handbook of Pest Control**.



Mr. Jeffrey Tucker

Mr. Tucker received his B.S. in entomology from Texas A&M University. He is a consulting entomologist and serves as president of Entomology Associates, Inc. He is a board-certified entomologist, registered sanitarian and certified pest control operator.
